**FIRE PROTECTION CAPITAL RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 1000, 2019**

A Bylaw to authorize the expenditure of funds from the  
Fire Protection Capital Reserve Fund

WHEREAS:

- A. There is an estimated unappropriated balance of \$ 305,530 in the Fire Protection Capital Reserve Fund.
- B. Council for the Village of Burns Lake deems it desirable to expend the sum of \$ 283,661 from the Reserve Fund to facilitate the acquisition of certain capital assets.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Burns Lake in Open Meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**1. Citation:**

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "The Corporation of the Village of Burns Lake Fire Protection Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 1000, 2019",

**2. Appropriation**

The sum of \$ 283,661 is hereby appropriated from the Reserve Fund for the following purchases in the approved 2019-2023 Financial Plan:

The appropriated funds will be transferred from the Reserve Fund to the Capital Fund to finance the above purchases.

**3. Authority to Transfer**

The Chief Financial Officer of the Village is hereby empowered to do all acts necessary to give effect to the transfer of funds provided for in this Bylaw.

**4. Unused Monies**

If any of the monies transferred from the Reserve Fund to the Capital Fund as contemplated in this Bylaw remain unexpended when each project is complete, those funds will be returned to the Reserve Fund.
