On page 2 of this form, you have the option to select whether your ballot package is to be mailed or whether you will pick it up in person at the Village Office. Make sure to select one.

Please note that it is the responsibility of the elector to allow adequate time to receive a package and submit the completed ballot.

If you are a non-resident property elector, you must ensure that the Non-Resident Property Elector Form (NRPE) is received at the Village Office **before October 3, 2022**, or a mail ballot will not be issued to you. A mail ballot package will not be sent until the NRPE form is received.

Resident mail ballot requests received after October 3, 2022, must be picked up in-person at the Village of Burns Lake municipal office.

It is the voter's responsibility to return the mail ballot before the close of general voting on **Saturday, October 15, at 8:00 pm**. Your mail ballot will be accepted at voting locations. Please note that once you have registered to vote by mail ballot in the 2022 Election, this is the only way you can vote in this election. You cannot vote again in-person at the regular or advanced polls.

a non-resident owner of real property in the municipality for at least 30 days immediately before the day of voter registration (October 15); **AND**
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting and am not otherwise disqualified by law
