- Plan for removal and transportation of equipment
- Proposed return consideration for the Village; This could include (but is not limited to):
  - o Monetary consideration
  - o Excavation services
  - o Base prep/drainage installation services

The Village will select the successful proposal based on the level of demonstrated benefit to the community.
