



## The Village of Burns Lake PUBLIC WORKS SEASONAL LABOURERS

The Village of Burns Lake is seeking qualified, competent and committed individuals for seasonal employment opportunities with the Village Public Works Department for the 2024 summer season.

Applicants must be adaptable, able to work with others or independently, able to communicate courteously and effectively with co-workers and the general public, and must be able to perform general duties associated with their position. Applicants are required to hold a valid Class 5 driver's licence. This position requires an individual who enjoys working outside. These positions are funded through the Canada Summer Jobs program; therefore, applicants must be between 15-30 years old. Applicants are not required to be a student.

General duties include:

- the operation of tools and equipment required for grass maintenance
- general maintenance and clean-up of municipal owned infrastructure
- and other duties as assign by the supervisor
- Applicants must hold a valid class 7 ("N") or class 5 drivers license.

Applicants must submit a detailed resume with a cover letter reflecting their knowledge, skills, abilities and enthusiasm relevant to the position.

- Tentative dates of work are between June-August, 2025 with the possibility of starting earlier or ending later depending on worker availability and departmental needs.
- This position is up to 40 hours per week between Monday-Friday each week.
- The 2025 wage for this position is \$20.72/hour.
